	Unit has a permanent label identifying make, model and serial number. IN 1.14		
	Unit is installed in a non-hazardous location maintaining proper clearance and does not compromise the structural integrity of the building. <i>IN 1.14 and IN 1.15</i>		
	Vent connectors entering a masonry chimney are properly secured and sealed tightly at the entrance point. WH 2.1		
	Entire gas line from meter to appliance is free of leaks. IN 1.15		
	Water heater is strapped on the upper third and lower third of the tank to resist horizontal displacement caused by seismic motion. WH 1.0		
	Water temperature is set no higher than 120°F. WH 1.0		
	Exhaust flue vent connections are secured with screws and exhaust flue is adequately sloped. WH 2.0 and WH 2.1		
	Unit is installed in accordance with manufacturer's specifications and jurisdictional codes. IN 1.14
