



CASH INCENTIVES FOR RELIGIOUS AND COMMUNITY SPACES

Investing in energy-efficient equipment helps reduce operations and maintenance costs, while improving comfort. That's why Energy Trust of Oregon offers cash incentives to lower upfront costs and make energy-saving upgrades more accessible.

Below are just a few incentives available to assembly spaces. The fuel type symbol indicates the fuel type provided by a participating utility that the site must have in order to qualify for the incentive. The dual fuel symbol signifies that a site may have either fuel type provided by a participating utility.

FUEL TYPE

-  Electric only

HVAC AND WATER HEATING

EQUIPMENT	REQUIREMENTS*	INCENTIVE
Commercial Heat Pump - New or Replacement 	- Qualifying building types include office, retail, restaurant, schools, or assembly-type buildings. These spaces in mixed-use buildings qualify. - Ductless, ducted or single-package heat pump must be AHRI-certified and have less than 65,000 Btu/h or 5.4 tons of cooling capacity.	\$200 - \$350 per ton
Commercial Heat Pump - Upgrade from electric resistance heat 	Must upgrade a primary, existing, functioning electric resistance heating system, which includes but is not limited to baseboard, wall heaters and electric forced-air furnace.	\$1,250-\$1,500 per ton
Commercial Smart Thermostat 	- Must control a single-zone HVAC system with dedicated supply fan - Spaces with 24/7 operation and semi-conditioned spaces do not qualify	\$200 - \$400 each
Gas-fired High-Efficiency Condensing HVAC Boiler 	Must be used for hydronic heating (HVAC) purposes: boilers used for domestic hot water (DHW), pool heating, and "heat adders" that serve water-source heat pump systems do not qualify	\$6.50 per kBtu/h
Commercial Condensing Gas Furnace 	- Must be primary heating source for the space - Input capacity, as listed by AHRI must be less than 225 kBtu/h	\$8.25 per kBtu/h input

INSULATION

EQUIPMENT	REQUIREMENTS*	INCENTIVE
Above Deck Roof Insulation 	- No existing insulation or existing insulation must be R-5 or less - Insulate to at least R-30 efficiency rating. If R-30 insulation requirements cannot be met due to existing site restrictions, a minimum of R-15 must be achieved	\$1.00 - \$2.85 per sq. ft
Attic or Below Deck Roof Insulation 	- No existing insulation or existing insulation must be R-5 or less - Insulate to at least R-38 efficiency rating or fill cavity	\$0.90 per sq. ft
Wall Insulation 	- No existing insulation or existing insulation condition must be R-5 or less - Insulate to at least R-20 efficiency rating or fill cavity	\$1.30 per sq ft

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

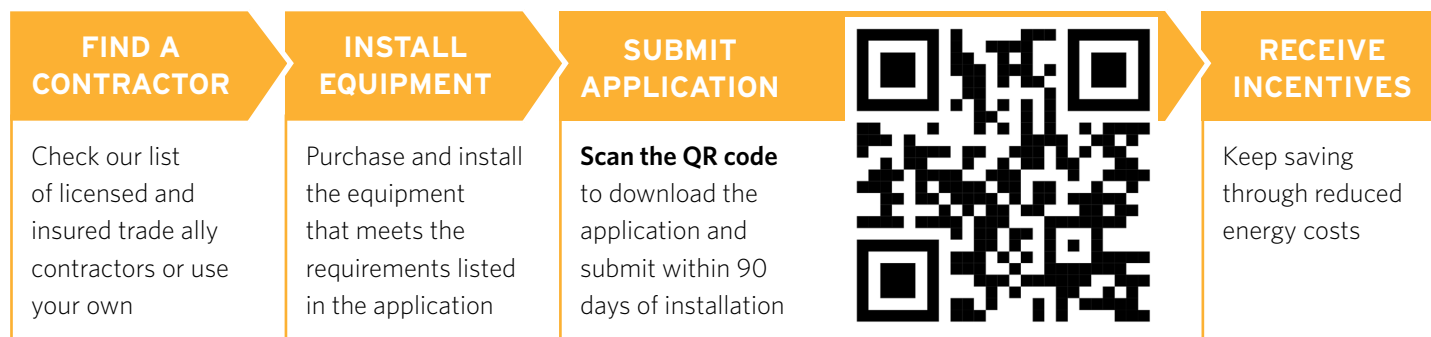
Cash incentives are available for qualifying equipment upgrades to commercial buildings. To qualify, you must:

- » Be improving an existing structure in Oregon
- » Receive utility service from Portland General Electric, Pacific Power, NW Natural, Cascade Natural Gas or Avista

CUSTOM OPPORTUNITIES

Not seeing what you’re looking for? Your project may be eligible for cash incentives through Energy Trust’s custom offering. Cash incentives for qualified custom energy projects are calculated based on estimated annual energy savings. Controls, chillers, variable frequency drives and retrocommissioning are a few examples.
