



CASH INCENTIVES FOR GAS EQUIPMENT UPGRADES

That's why Energy Trust of Oregon offers cash incentives to lower upfront costs and make energy-saving upgrades more accessible. Below are just a few of the gas incentives and their requirements. HVAC AND WATER HEATING

EQUIPMENT	REQUIREMENTS*	INCENTIVE
Steam Traps	- Must replace or repair a failed, open existing steam trap - All steam traps in the system must be tested for failure status prior to replacement or repair	\$400-\$500 each
Gas-fired High-Efficiency Condensing HVAC Boiler	Minimum 94% efficiency, either Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency (AFUE) or Thermal Efficiency	\$6.50 per kBtu/h input
Commercial Condensing Gas Furnace	- Input capacity, as listed by AHRI, must be less than 225,000 Btu/h - Must have at least 95% Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency (AFUE)	\$8.25 per kBtu
Infrared Radiant Heaters	Must be natural gas-fired, low intensity, non-condensing and positive pressure system	\$4.00-\$5.00 per kBtu/h input
Commercial Condensing Gas Tank Water Heater	- Water heater input capacity, as listed by AHRI, must be greater than 75 kBtu/h per water heater - Must have at least 94% thermal efficiency (TE) or recovery efficiency	\$3.50 per kBtu/h input
Commercial Smart Thermostat	- Must control a single-zone HVAC system with dedicated supply fan - Spaces with 24/7 operation and semi-conditioned spaces do not qualify	\$400 each

FOODSERVICE & LODGING

EQUIPMENT	REQUIREMENTS*	INCENTIVE
Ozone Laundry System	- Each ozone laundry system must be new and installed on either new or existing programmable commercial washing machine(s) - Each ozone generator may serve one or more washers	\$5,000-\$30,000 per system
Gas Oven (Convection or Combination)	Must be active on ENERGY STAR certified product list (version 3.0)	\$500 each
Gas Steam Cooker	- Must hold at least 3 pans - Steam cookers may be boilerless or steam generator type	\$1,000 each
Gas Griddle (single-sided)	Must be active on the ENERGY STAR® 1.2 certified product list	\$1,000 each
Automatic Conveyor Broiler	- Broiler must have an automatic conveyor with catalyst - For gas-fired broilers, input rate must be below 80 kBtu/h or dual stage or modulating gas valve with a capability of throttling the input rate below 80 kBtu/h	\$2,500-\$3,500 each
High Efficiency Gas Fryer	Gas fryer must be on the Qualified Product List and must be active on ENERGY STAR certified product list (version 3.0)	\$1,500- \$2,000 each

INSULATION

EQUIPMENT	REQUIREMENTS*	INCENTIVE
Above Deck Roof Insulation	- No existing insulation or existing insulation must be R-5 or less - Insulate to at least R-30 efficiency rating. If R-30 insulation requirements cannot be met due to existing site restrictions, a minimum of R-15 must be achieved	\$1.00 - \$2.85 per sq ft
Attic or Below Deck Roof Insulation	- No existing insulation or existing insulation must be R-5 or less - Insulate to at least R-38 efficiency rating or fill cavity	\$0.90 per sq ft
Wall Insulation	- No existing insulation or existing insulation condition must be R-5 or less - Insulate to at least R-20 efficiency rating or fill cavity	\$1.30 per sq ft

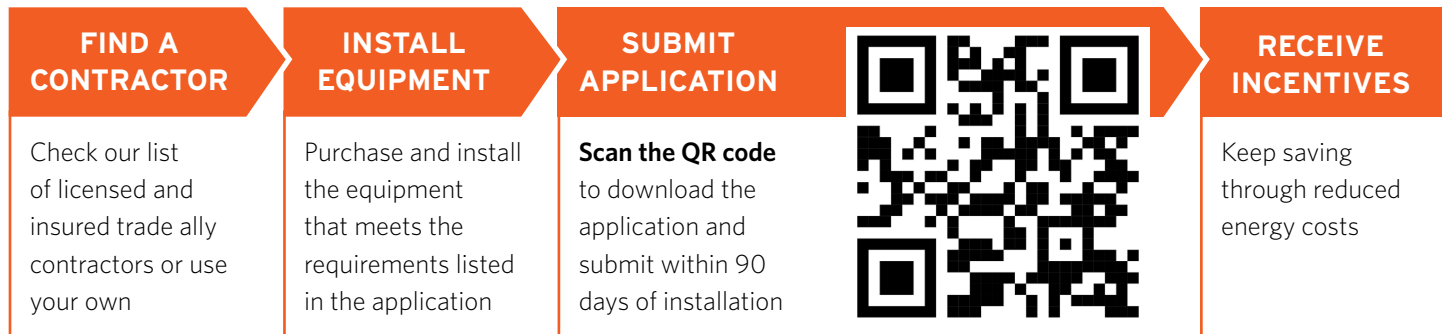


ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

Cash incentives are available for qualifying gas equipment upgrades to commercial buildings. To qualify, you must:

- » Be improving an existing structure in Oregon
- » Receive utility service from NW Natural, Cascade Natural Gas or Avista
