



## CASH INCENTIVES FOR HEALTHCARE

To keep costs low and ensure patients receive the best care possible, healthcare organizations of all sizes need to look for ways to improve their operations. Below are just a few incentives available to healthcare buildings. The fuel type symbol indicates the fuel type provided by a participating utility that the site must have in order to qualify for the incentive. The dual fuel symbol signifies that a site may have either fuel type provided by a participating utility.

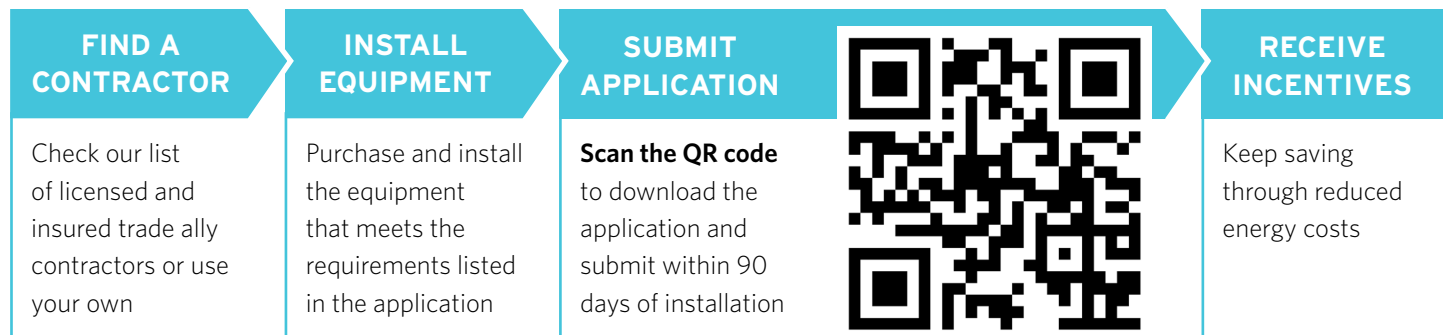
## ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?
