



CASH INCENTIVES FOR RESTAURANTS

To stay competitive, restaurant and foodservice businesses of all sizes need to look for ways to stretch every dollar. Investing in energy-efficient equipment helps reduce operations and maintenance costs, while improving comfort for your customers. That's why Energy Trust of Oregon offers cash incentives to lower upfront costs and make energy-saving upgrades more accessible.

Below are just a few incentives available to restaurants. The fuel type symbol indicates the fuel type provided by a participating utility that the site must have in order to qualify for the incentive. The dual fuel symbol signifies that a site may have either fuel type provided by a participating utility.

EQUIPMENT		REQUIREMENTS (ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS MAY APPLY)	INCENTIVE
Electric or Gas Combination Oven (5-40 Pan Capacity)		Must be active on the ENERGY STAR® 3.0 certified product list	\$500 - \$3,000 each
Electric or Gas Steam Cooker		- Must hold at least 3 pans - Steam cookers may be boilerless or steam generator type	\$400 - \$2,000 each
Commercial Stationary and Conveyor Dishwashers		- Must be active on the ENERGY STAR® 3.0 certified product list - Dual or high temperature	\$750 - \$1,200 each
Commercial Vent Hood with Demand Controlled Ventilation		- Vent hood with demand controlled ventilation may either be newly installed or upgrading from an existing system. - Controls must modulate airflows based on sensed cooking activity (for example infrared, optical, temperature sensors)	Incentives available. Contact the program for details.
Electric or Gas Griddle (Single-Sided)		Must be active on the ENERGY STAR® 1.2 certified product list	\$1,000 each
High Efficiency Electric or Gas Fryer		Gas fryer must be on the Qualified Product List and must be active on ENERGY STAR certified product list (version 3.0)	\$800 - \$2,000 each

HVAC AND WATER HEATING

EQUIPMENT		REQUIREMENTS (ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS MAY APPLY)	INCENTIVE
Commercial Condensing Tank Water Heater		- Gas-condensing, storage-type with integral tank volume at least 10 gallons - Input capacity greater than 75 kBtu/h - Minimum 94% thermal efficiency or recovery efficiency	\$3.50 per kBtu/h input
Commercial Heat Pump - Upgrade at a Restaurant		- Ductless, ducted or single-package heat pump must AHRI-certified and have less than 65,000 Btu/h or 5.4 tons of cooling capacity - Restaurants in mixed-use buildings also qualify	\$2,000 - \$2,500 per ton
Commercial Smart Thermostat		- Must control a single-zone HVAC system with dedicated supply fan - Spaces with 24/7 operation and semi-conditioned spaces do not qualify	\$200 - \$400 each

INSULATION

EQUIPMENT	REQUIREMENTS (ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS MAY APPLY)	INCENTIVE
Above Deck Roof Insulation 	- No existing insulation or existing insulation must be R-5 or less - Insulate to at least R-30 efficiency rating. If R-30 insulation requirements cannot be met due to existing site restrictions, a minimum of R-15 must be achieved	\$1.00 - \$2.85 per sq ft
Wall Insulation 	- No existing insulation or existing insulation must be R-5 or less - Insulate to at least R-20 efficiency rating or fill cavity	\$1.30 per sq ft
Pipe Insulation 	- Must insulate bare pipe with no existing insulation or replace insulation that is aged, wet, or damaged - Jacketing should protect insulation based on environmental conditions to preserve its lifespan—typically ASJ or PVC in indoor applications - Insulation must be at least one inch thick	\$18 - \$30 per linear ft

CUSTOM OPPORTUNITIES

Not seeing what you're looking for? Your project may be eligible for cash incentives through Energy Trust's custom offering. Cash incentives for qualified custom energy projects are calculated based on estimated annual energy savings. Controls, chillers, variable frequency drives and retrocommissioning are a few examples.

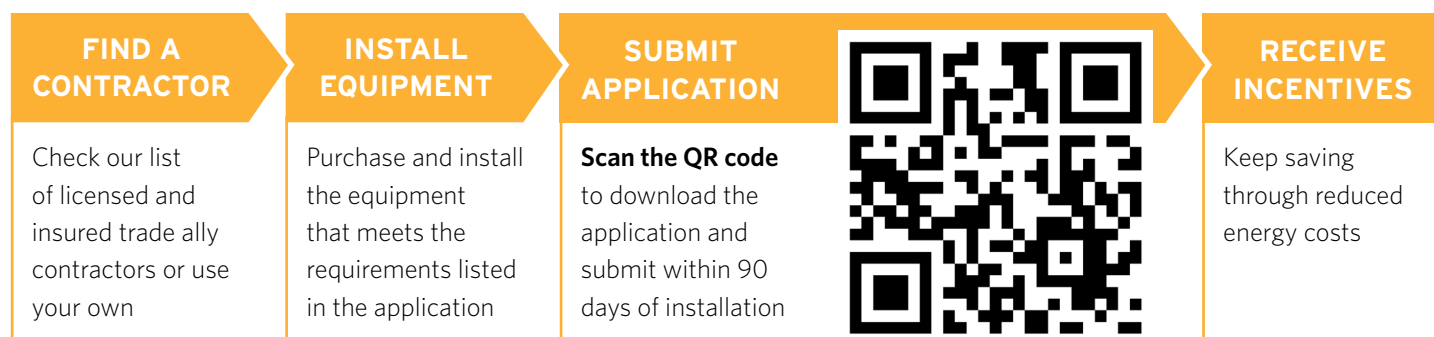


ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

Cash incentives are available for qualifying equipment upgrades to commercial buildings. To qualify, you must:

- » Be improving an existing structure in Oregon
- » Receive utility service from Portland General Electric, Pacific Power, NW Natural, Cascade Natural Gas or Avista
