This form must be completed by the builder of the home. The customer's solar trade ally contractor must then submit it to Energy Trust of Oregon with a Solar incentive application and, if applicable, a Battery Storage incentive application prior to beginning work on the project.

- 2) **All Income:** Energy Trust offers standard solar incentives and standard battery storage incentives to all Energy Trust customers, with no income qualification required for the sale of the home.

Note: Income includes all gross wages, tips, rental income, public assistance, social security or pensions, income from self-employment, alimony, interest or any other sources of income defined by the IRS income tax return for the previous tax year.
