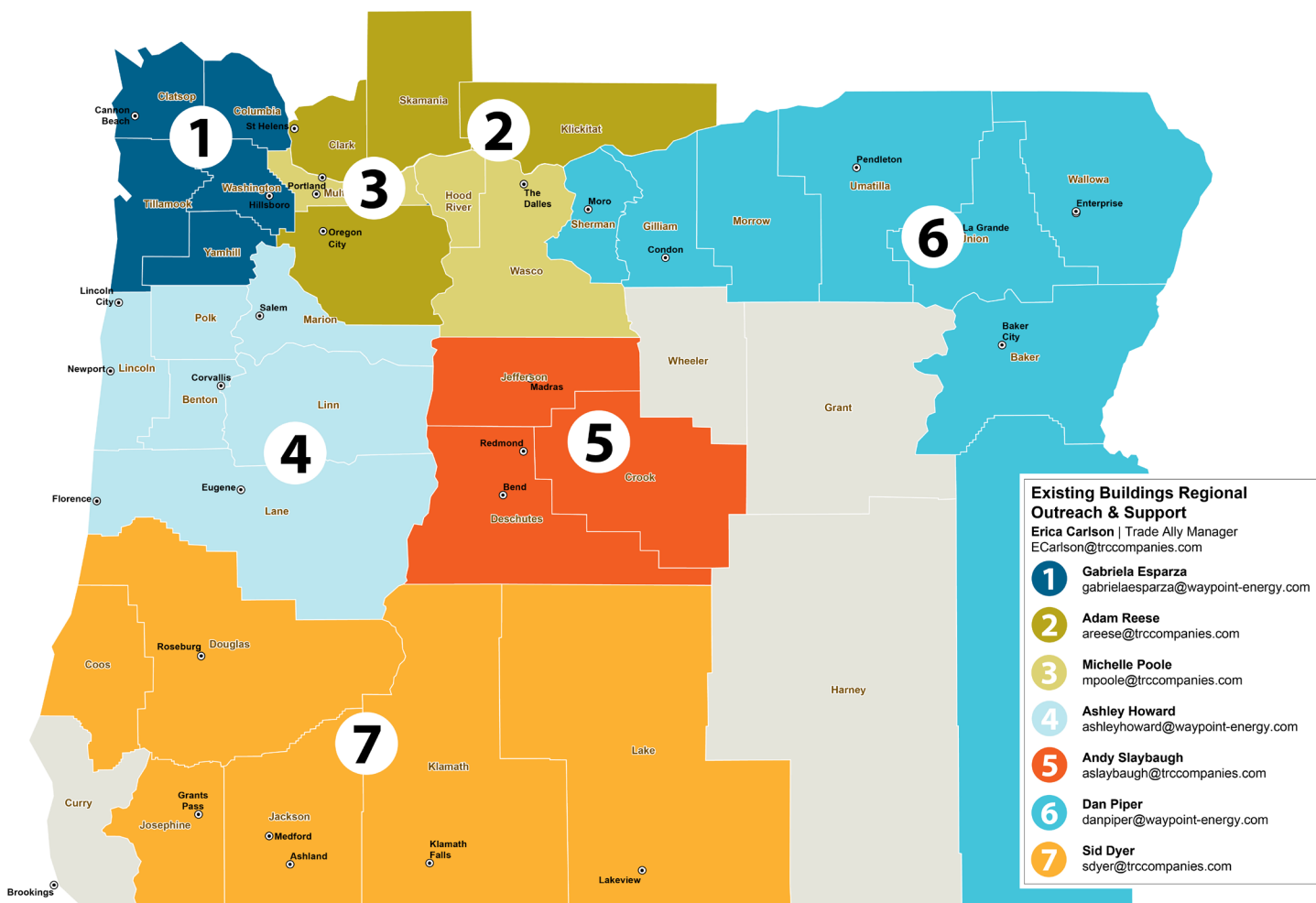


EXISTING BUILDINGS PROGRAM CONTACT INFORMATION
