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

Outdoor Spa Cover	Must be purchased through a participating retailer, visit www.energytrust.org/residential . Spa must be located outside and heated with electricity or natural gas. Heat Pump Upgrade	HSPF 9.5 or greater. Incentive only available for homes upgrading existing heat pump or upgrading non-electric heat (example: gas, propane, wood or oil). Heat pump must be used as the primary heat source.	\$500	Up to \$1125. For details, visit www.oregon.gov/energy.

Important Existing Homes Terms and Conditions:

- Hybrid HVAC incentives are paid for primary heat source only. Backup systems do not qualify for incentives.
- Application must be submitted within 60 days from initial installation. Application must be complete and accurate for incentives to be paid.
- All required documentation, including contractor invoices marked "paid in full", must be submitted with the incentive application.
- All incentives other than heat pump lockout controls are paid directly to customers unless part of an instant incentive project.
- A non-trade ally contractor can install certain upgrades but must have a current Oregon Construction Contractors Board (CCB) license.
